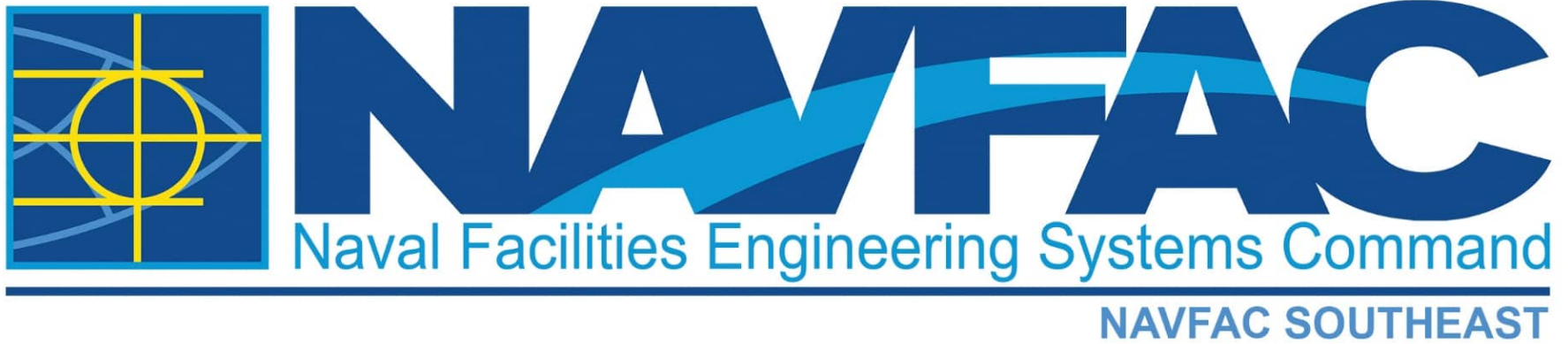


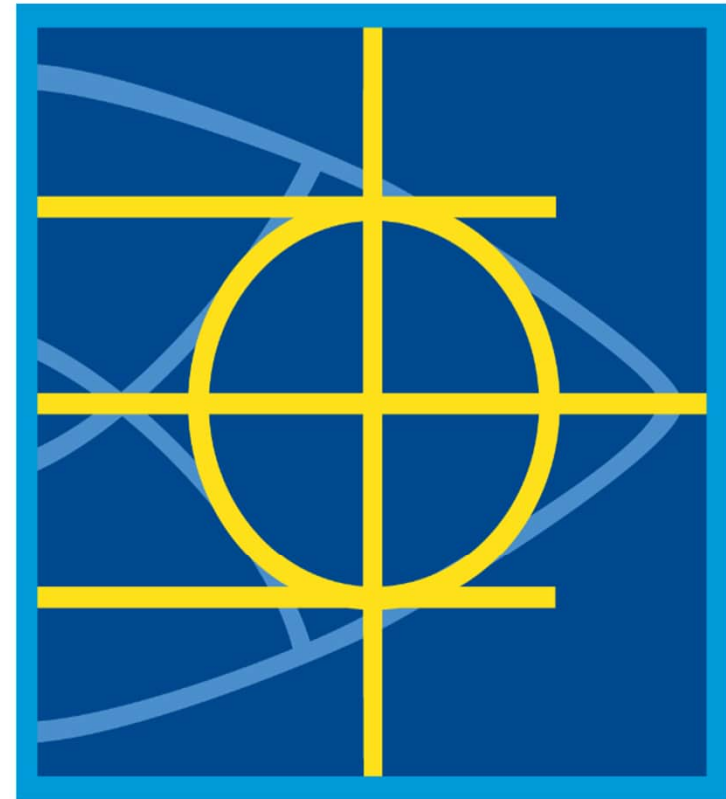

 - Plan, build, maintain sustainable facilities
 - Deliver environmental, utilities, and other base services
 - Program Executive Office Industrial Infrastructure (PEO II) for Shipyard Infrastructure Optimization Plan (SIOP), \$21B over 20 year

- NAVFAC SE – one of nine Facilities Engineering Commands within the NAVFAC SYSCOM

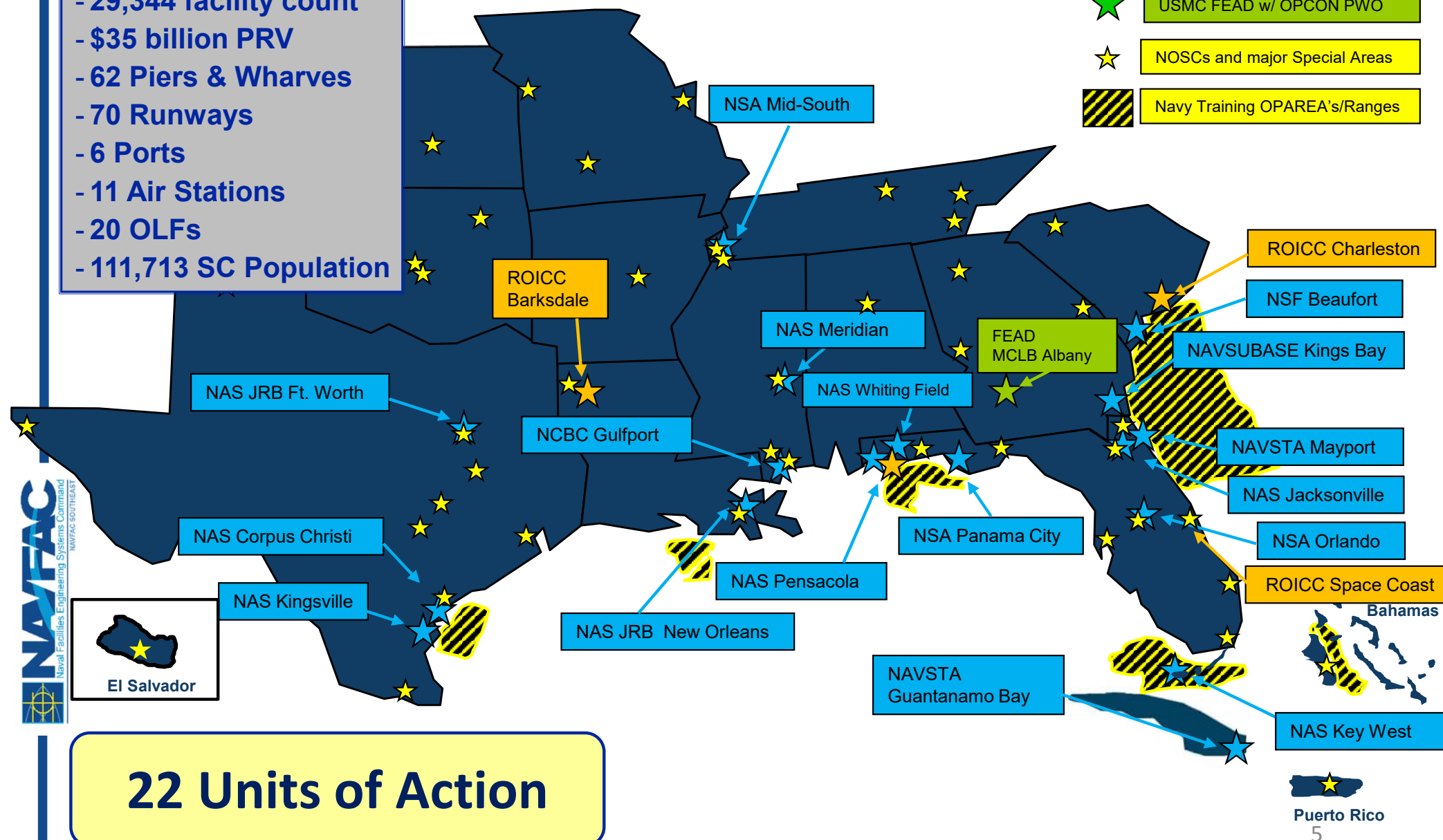

What's Shaping Us Right Now?

- **Shore C2 – Navy initiative to improve clear lines of Command and Control (C2) - resulting from outcomes associated with the "Red Hill fuel leak" and the fire on the USS Bonhomme Richard (LHD-6)**
 - Aligns Public Work Departments Requirements and Production Divisions to the Installation Commanders
 - Today's FEAD becomes tomorrows ROICC
 - Environmental and Public Works aligned to Regional Commander
 - Functional realignment by TYCOM and SYSCOM function
- **PBIS FTE Control**
 - POTUS efforts for Federal Government downsizing is in play with DOD
 - Force-shaping is being managed by assigning and enforcing an FTE control moving forward
 - Our assigned control reduces our FY25 authorization by just over 30%

NAVFAC SYSCOM Strategic Guidance

Line of Effort 1: Sharpen NAVFAC's focus on **C**onstruction, **E**ngineering, and **C**ontracting

Line of Effort 2: Drive NAVFAC toward a lean, accountable and integrated organization

Line of Effort 3: Recruit, develop and retain a NAVFAC workforce that drives readiness and deterrence

CNIC/NAVFAC Shore C2 Initiative Update

- Reorganization of Shore Requirements, Environmental, and the delivery of Operations & Maintenance Public Works functions is being realigned across the Navy - from NAVFAC to CNIC
- Why? To improve accountability. Navy wants the Installation Commanders to be accountable for ashore infrastructure outcomes
- Timeline – 2 stages. First is in January of 2026 and the 2nd stage TBD, but it will be sooner than later in the 2026 CY
- At the same time this is happening, DOD/DON is undergoing downsizing as well. Unrelated to this migration, both residual sides will be smaller than today
- Workload is projected to continue to increase through these conditions
- We'll need increased industry partnerships and tools moving forward
- For example: CAT III/IV projects (development of scope for projects that do not require engineering support), Construction ET project oversight, Fire Protection Engineering support, Cost and Scheduling support, smaller CAT II type A&E support (<\$10M range), establishment of local JOC contracts – just to name a few

 - 7 Stand-alone projects – the rest of planned projects will utilize existing tools
 - **500+ projects < \$1M, and another ~ \$250M (FSRM)**
- **Base Operations Support Contracts (BOSC or FSC) - \$359M/year**
- **Environment Contracts - \$108M**
- **Average Unplanned Work in SE ~ \$500M/year**

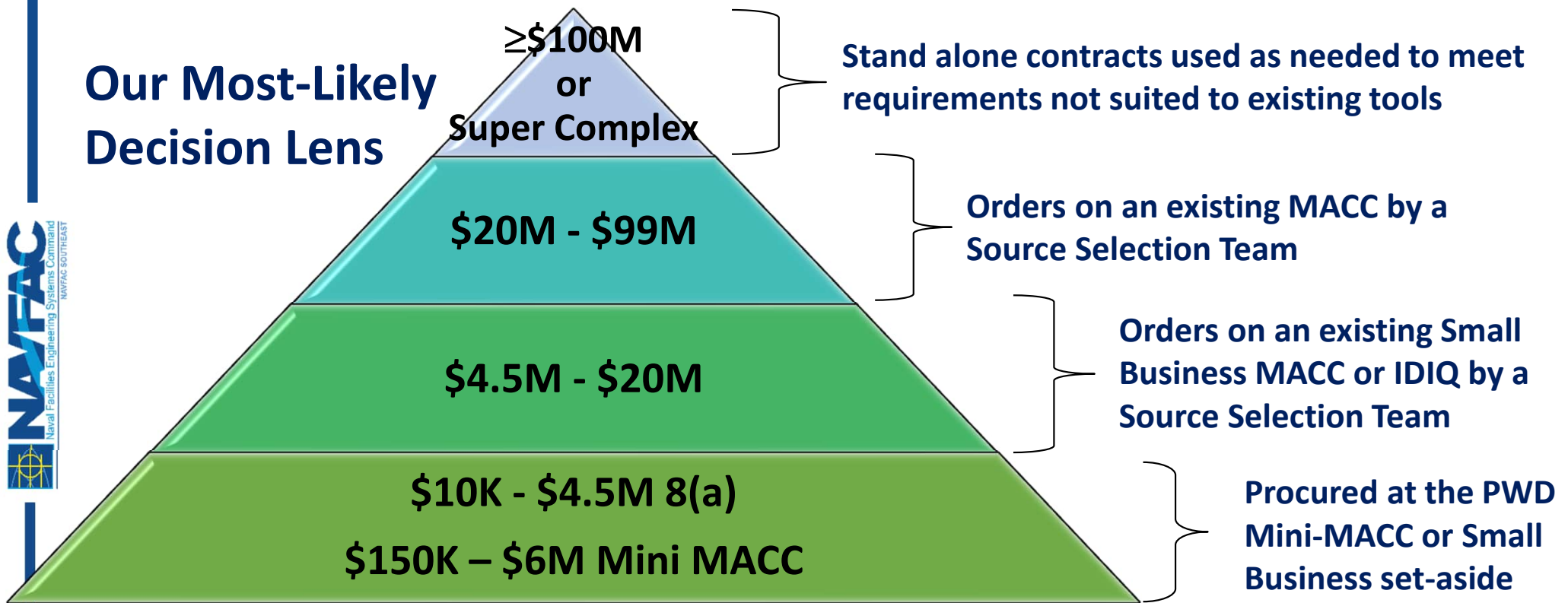

NAVFAC SE Acquisition Strategy - Construction

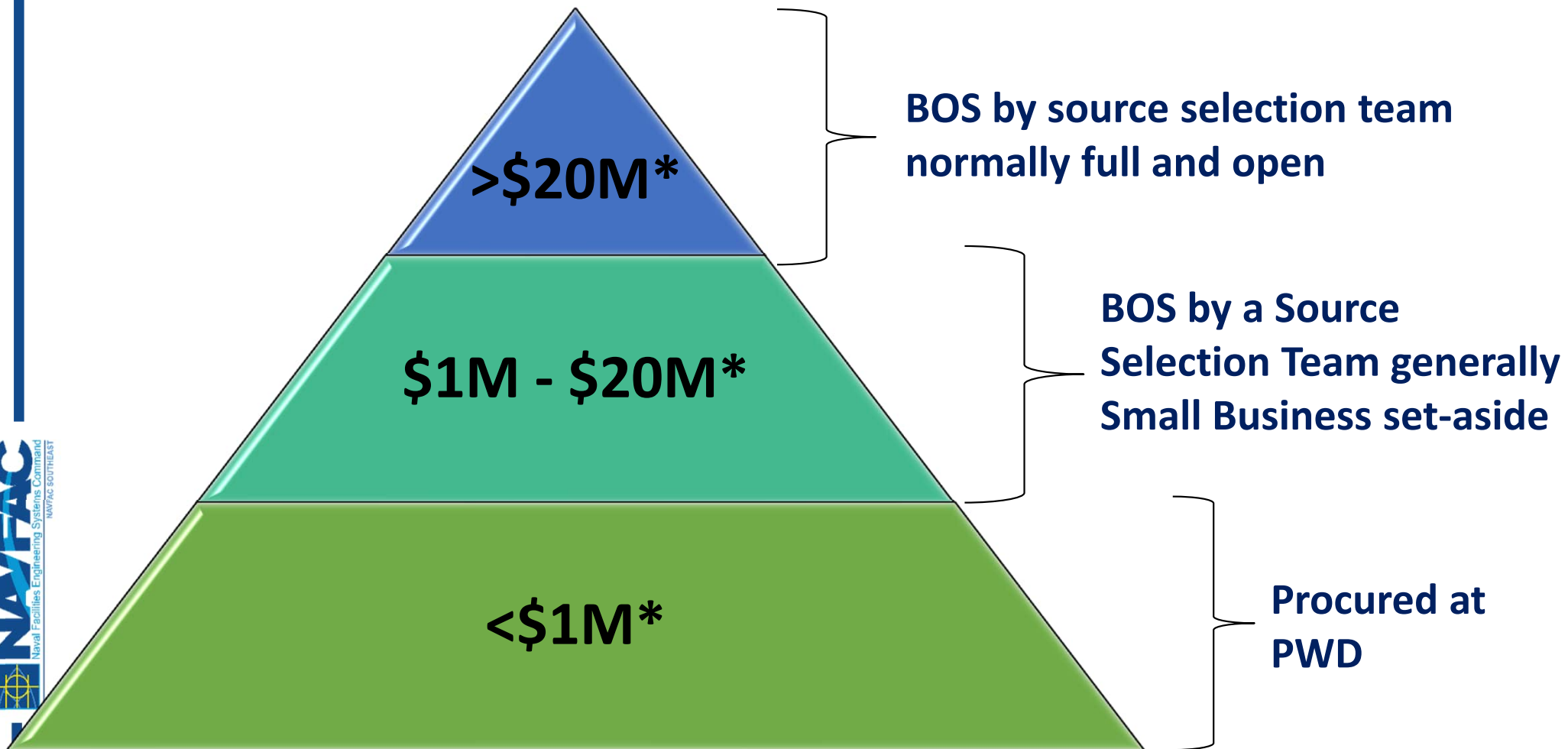
- **Multiple Award Construction Contract (MACC) task order is generally preferred method**
 - Prequalified contractors and provides us more speed than stand alone
 - Competitive award - orders competed among MACC awardees
- **Stand-alone contracts used when determined appropriate, based on a variety of factors**

NAVFAC SE Acquisition Strategy - Facilities Services

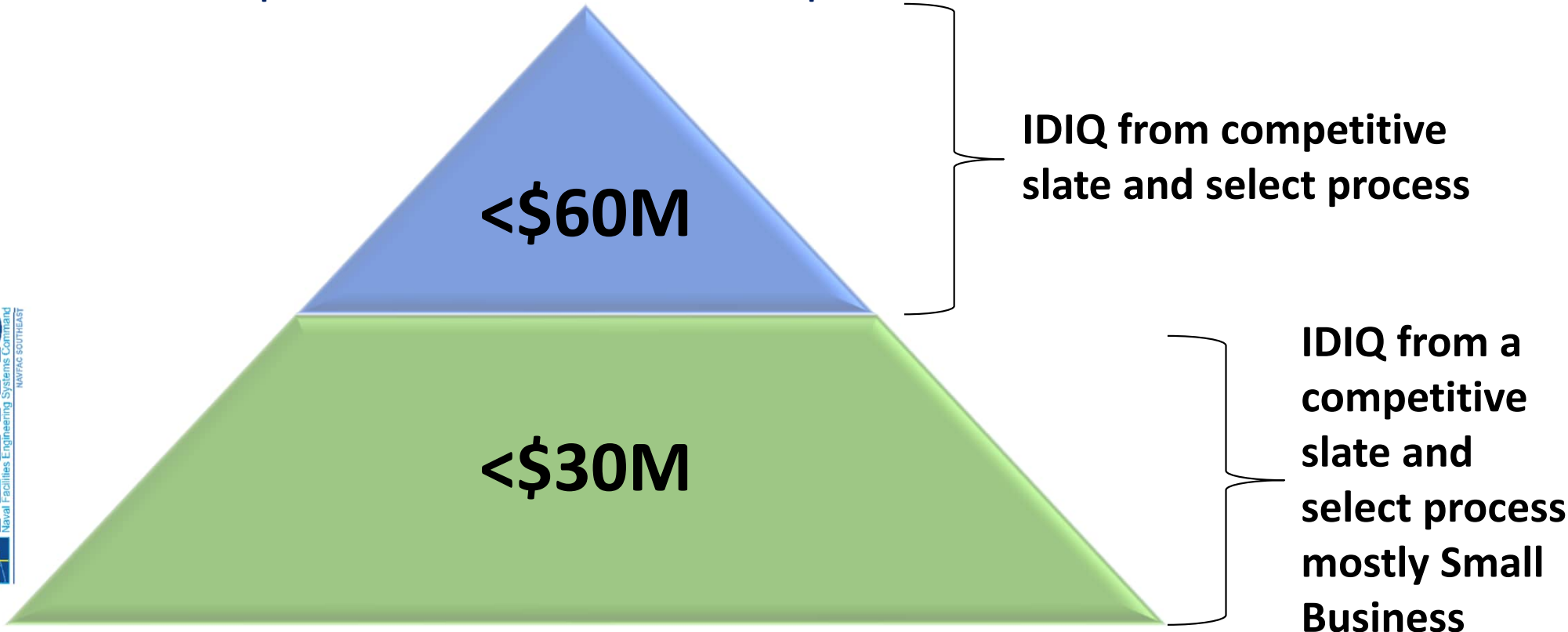
- Strategy heavily influenced by market research results - small businesses meets the majority of requirements

- **AE/EV-IDIQ task order standard means of execution**
 - Most highly-qualified contractor, determined competitively by slate and select
 - Faster and more efficient than full and open competition
 - Competitive award, non-competitive orders

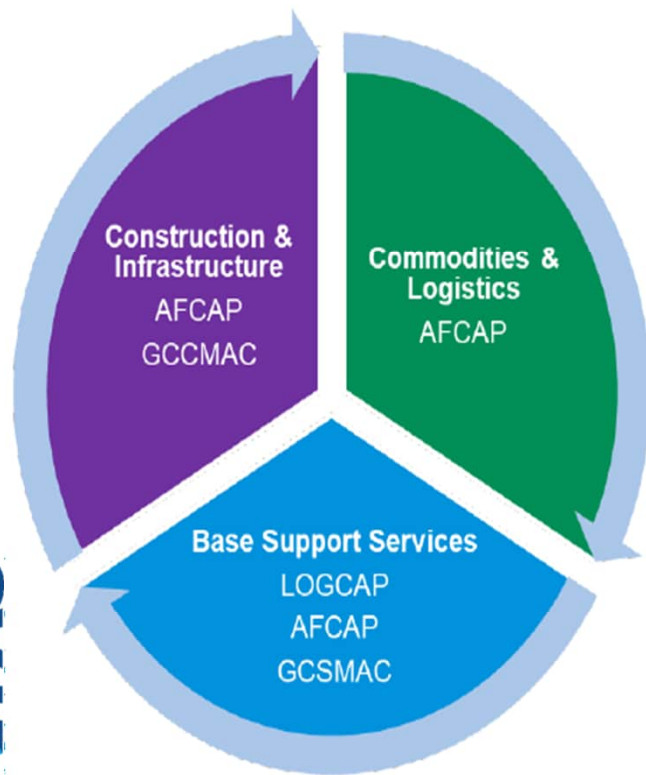

Comparison of the DoD CAP/MACs

(Slide from JETC 2023)



- LOGCAP may only perform construction and purchase commodities that are incidental to Base Support Services; Contracts can be FFP, CPFF
 - Task Order are typically Cost Plus Fixed Fee
- AFCAP has the ability to award stand alone task orders for Construction and Commodities (not incidental to BOS); Contracts can be FFP, CPFF, CPAF, CPIF
 - Task Orders are typically Firm-Fixed Price with some Cost Plus Fixed Fee
- GCSMAC focus is on short term / transitional BOS work; Contracts can be cost plus and Fixed Price Variations
 - NAVFAC Pacific tends toward CPAF task orders
- GCCMAC usually supports storm/disaster recovery at Navy and Marine Corp bases or urgently needed MILCON projects ; task orders can be FFP or CPAF
 - NAVFAC Atlantic tends toward FFP task orders

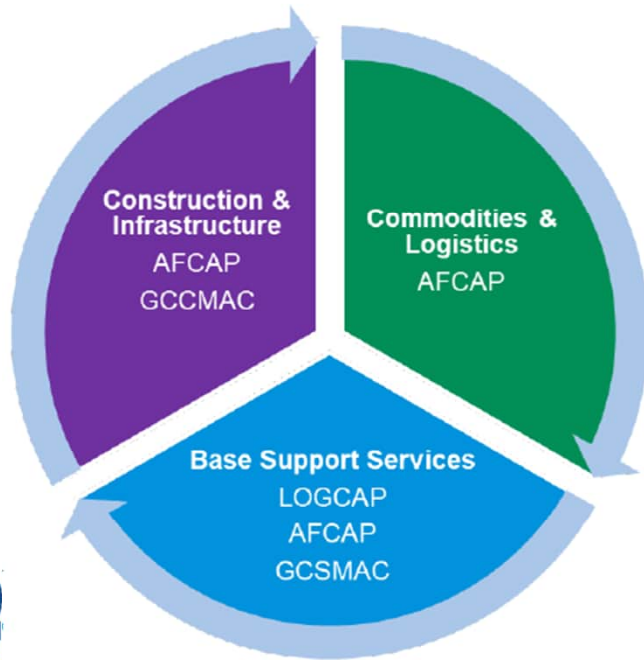

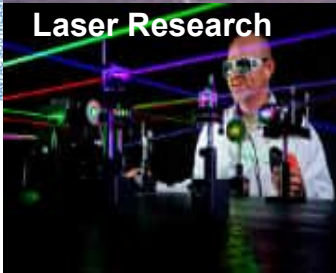

IT/Cyber Highlights

- **Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC)**

- Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC) program is aligned to DoD's information security requirements for DIB partners. It is designed to enforce protection of sensitive unclassified information that is shared by the Department with its contractors and subcontractors.
 - Tiered Model: CMMC requires that companies entrusted with national security information implement cybersecurity standards at progressively advanced levels, depending on the type and sensitivity of the information. The program also sets forward the process for requiring protection of information that is flowed down to subcontractors.
 - Assessment Requirement: CMMC assessments allow the Department to verify the implementation of clear cybersecurity standards.
 - Implementation through Contracts: Once CMMC is fully implemented, certain DoD contractors that handle sensitive unclassified DoD information will be required to achieve a particular CMMC level as a condition of contract award.

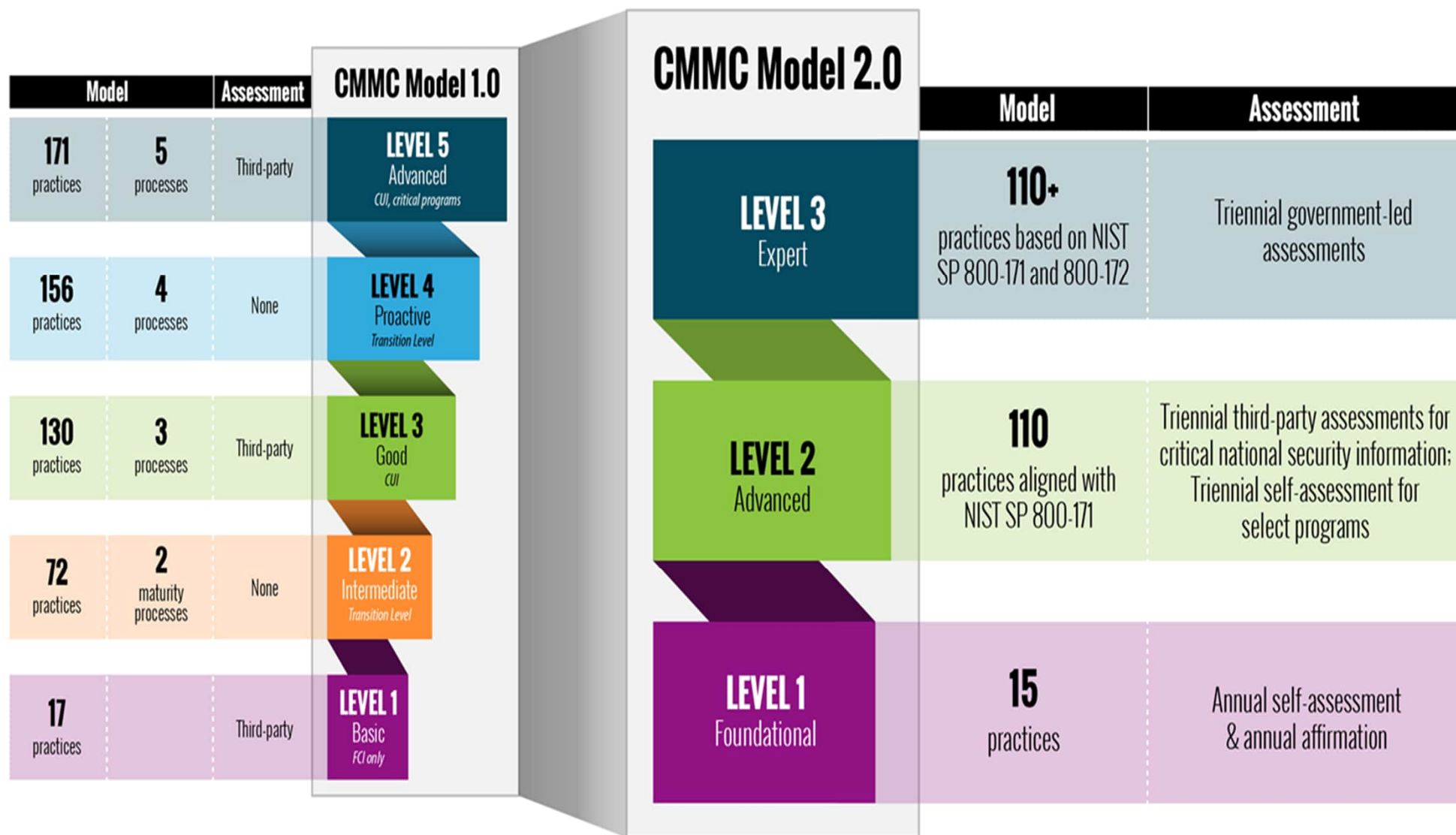

Model 2 simplifies the CMMC standard for companies, while safeguarding critical Department of Defense information

What is the difference between NIST SP 800-171 compliance and CMMC?

CMMC – is **designed to enforce** protection of sensitive unclassified information that is shared by the Department of Defense with its contractors and subcontractors. Requirements are based on NIST SP 800-171 guidelines.

NIST SP 800-171 - **provides recommended** security requirements for protecting the confidentiality of sensitive unclassified information residing in a nonfederal system and organization.

The major differences between these are:

- CMMC compliance does **not** necessarily mean NIST SP 800-171 compliance
- CMMC Level 1 is the lowest level of certification
- CMMC Level 2 & 3 requires application of NIST SP800-171 and associated NIST SP800-172 controls

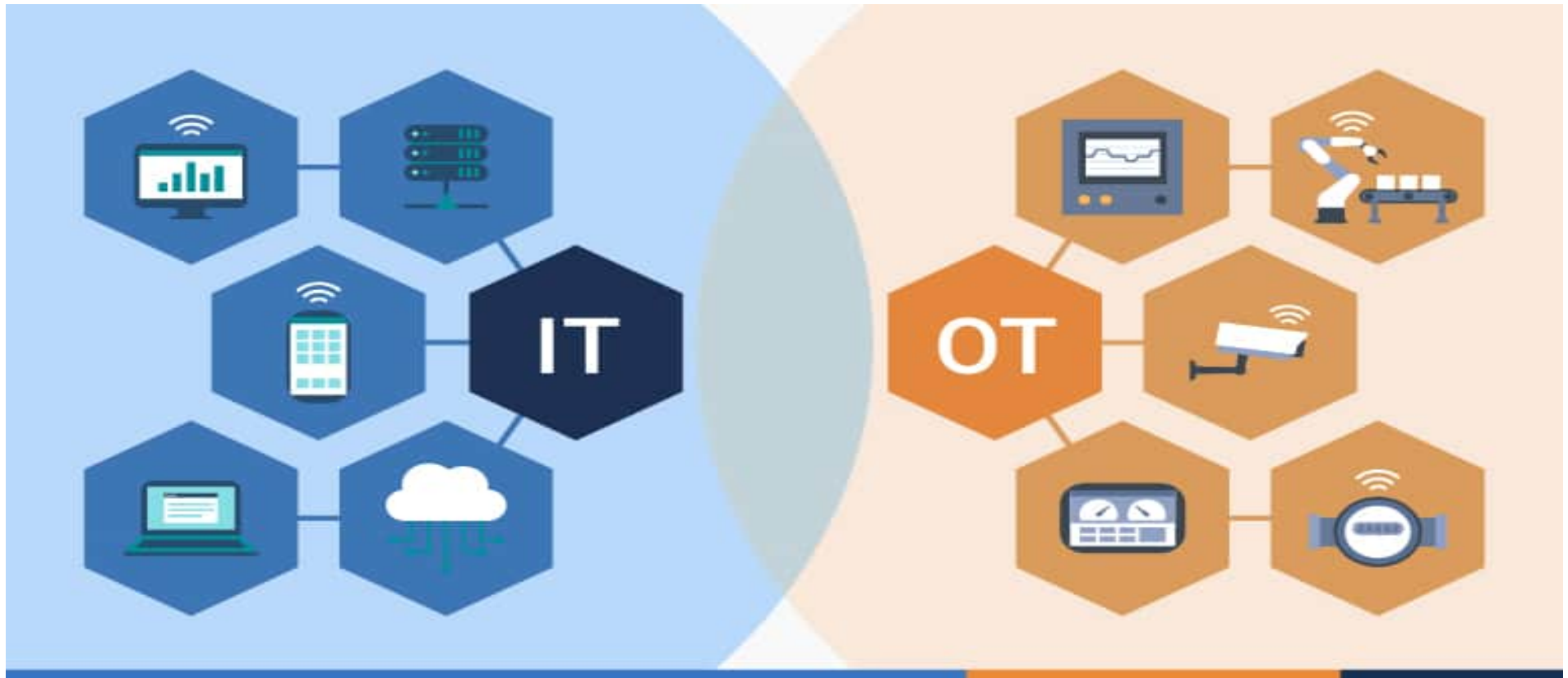

CMMC FAQs

What is the relationship between National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Special Publication (SP) 800-171 and CMMC?

Compliance with NIST standards are levied as contractual requirements via inclusion of clauses such as FAR 52.204-21 and DFARS 252.204-7012. The relationship between CMMC and the NIST standards is that CMMC requirements will result in a contractor self-assessment, or a third-party assessment, to determine whether the applicable NIST standard (as identified by the DFARS clause) has been met. The FAR clause states the basic safeguarding requirements for CMMC Level 1 compliance. Under CMMC 2.0, a Level 2 assessment will be conducted against the NIST SP 800-171 standard and a Level 3 assessment will be based on a subset of NIST SP 800-172 requirements.

Will prime contractors and subcontractors be required to maintain the same CMMC level?

If contractors and subcontractors are handling the same type of FCI and CUI, then the same CMMC level will apply. In cases where the prime only flows down select information, a lower CMMC level may apply to the subcontractor.

Would it be safe to say that customer data is CUI and administrative data is FCI?

The definition of FCI is in FAR 52.204-21 and CUI in 32 CFR Part 2002, respectively. The DoD CUI Quick Reference Guide, located at <https://www.dodcui.mil>, includes information on CUI. In addition, the Defense Counterintelligence and Security Agency (DCSA) provides answers to Frequently Asked Questions at: <https://www.dcsa.mil/Portals/91/Documents/CTP/CUI/21-10-13%20CUI%20FAQ%20FINAL.pdf>. These FAQs describe the difference between FCI and CUI as follows: “Both CUI and FCI include information created or collected by or for the Government, as well as information received from the Government. However, while FCI is any information that is ‘not intended for public release,’ CUI is information that requires safeguarding and may also be subject to dissemination controls.”
