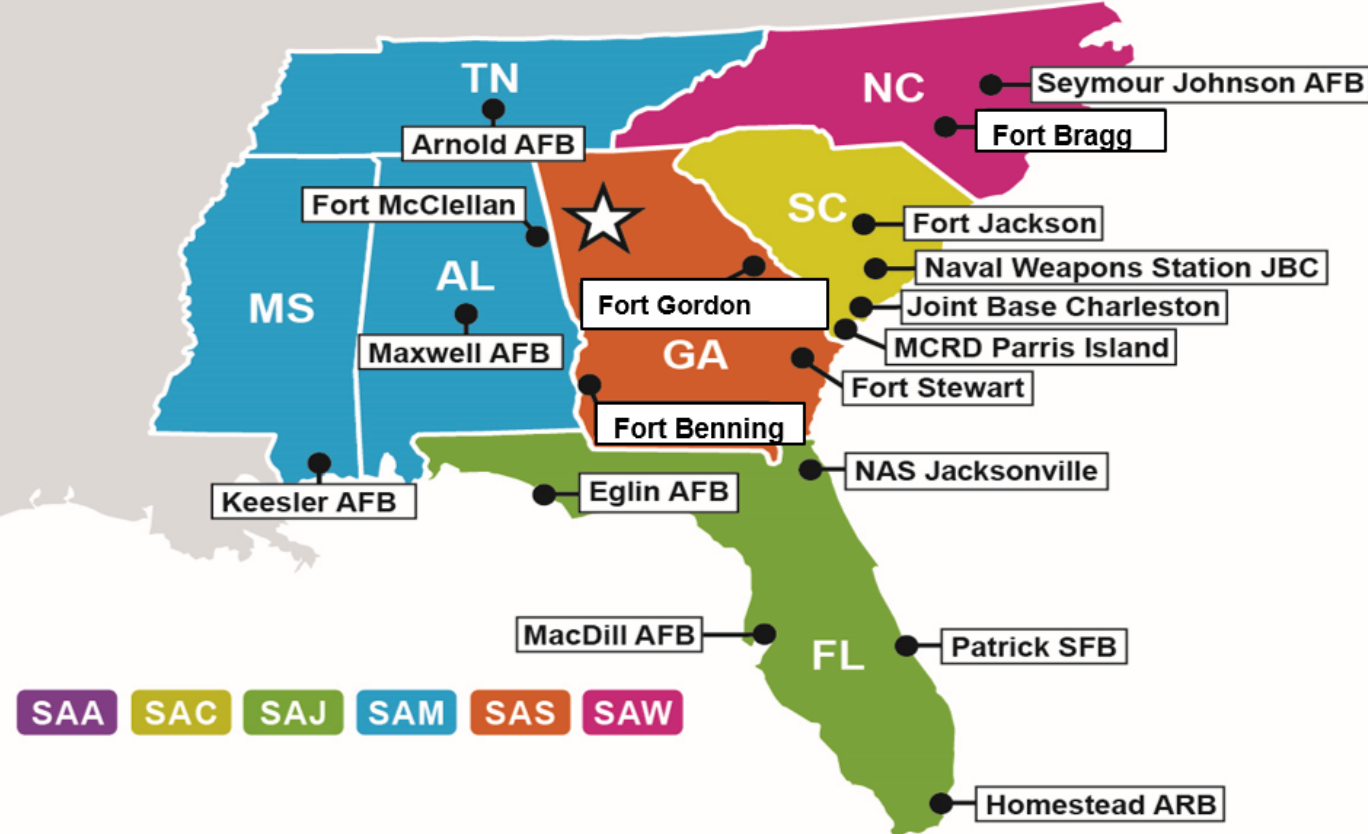

FEATURED PROGRAMS / PROJECTS



CIVIL WORKS PROGRAMS

Solve the Nation's water resources challenges and execute a robust Civil Works workload by leveraging Industry expertise and building adequate contract capacity with our Industry partners

Highlighted Opportunities:

1) Regional Emergency Action & Disaster Infrastructure (READI) IDIQ Contracts

- 1st Contract: AE Services Contract for Assessment and Technical Support
- 2nd Contract: MATOC with broad construction and rapid-response within SAD AOR
- Consideration of a separate READI Design MATOC for rapid-response AE Design
- Currently in acquisition planning phase

2) SAS O&M Construction IDIQs

- Two IDIQ requirements, one for general construction services, and one for heavy civil construction within the Savannah District AOR
- Currently in acquisition planning phase

3) A-E Civil Design IDIQ

- Follow-up to existing AE Civil Design Contract
- Currently in acquisition planning phase





CITY OF ATLANTA WATER INFRASTRUCTURE

PLANNING ASSISTANCE TO STATES

(PAS) study assess City of Atlanta's drinking water system.

Background:

A series of water line failures occurred in downtown Atlanta in late-May/early-Jun of 24, which caused widespread water outages in the surrounding areas. Upon request from the City of Atlanta, the Savannah and Mobile Districts mobilized personnel in less than one week, followed by approval of the PAS study and cost share waiver on 14 Jun 24.

PAS STUDY:

- Evaluates the current condition of the pipeline
- Estimates the remaining useful life of the asset.
- Develops a prioritized list of future actions to improve system resiliency
- Performs a water line condition assessment to identify critical risks.
- Guides the city in prioritizing future planning.
- Delivers a cost-effective, reliable, and defensible inspection strategy.
- Supports long-term capital planning for rehabilitation or replacement.

SUCCESS / CONCERNS

- Awarded an architectural/engineering contract in Q1 FY25 to conduct the water line condition assessment study, set to conclude in Q1 FY26.
- The AE, USACE, and the City of Atlanta actively collect data, despite challenges from the city's aging water line infrastructure that may hinder data collection and prioritization.



*"We are currently coordinating with the **US Army Corps of Engineers**. We have **sought their assistance because they have the most experience in handling a crisis like this**," Mayor Andre Dickens announced in a statement Monday. "They will help us develop a plan to assess and evaluate our aging infrastructure."*



DVA PROJECT

SAN JUAN, PR VAMC SEISMIC UPGRADES

Project Objectives = Enhance hospital safety and structural resilience to ensure continuity of critical services during emergencies

Background

- Seismic upgrades to ensure hospital can operate during/after major seismic events
- USACE conducting surveys and coordination planning to minimize service disruption during construction

Project Goals

- Improve structural resilience and life safety
- Maintain continuity of critical care services during emergencies
- Develop DB RFP for Priority 1 seismic projects
