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# ATLANTIC INTERCOASTAL WATERWAY

- The Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway (AIWW) is a Federal project, constructed and maintained by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Authorized in 1937)
- ~235 miles total length in S.C. (212 is maintained by Charleston District)
- 12' Depth and 90' Wide along its length.
- Periodic maintenance dredging is conducted where shoals exist to maintain navigation at those dimensions (subject to appropriations)

**Important Milestones to TSP to Reduce Uncertainties**

- Decision:** April 2025 – Work Plan Release / FY25 Earmark
- Scope Discussion:** December 2025 – Future Without Project Condition Modeling Complete
- Scope Discussion:** December 2026 – Final Array of Alternatives
- Scope Discussion/Decision:** August 2027 – Identify the Tentatively Selected Plan



### STUDY RISKS

- Multiple flood hazards with the study area create analytical complexity.
- Technical risks include engineering modeling to evaluate compound flood risks isn't aligned with Corps practice.
- Economic modeling will require innovative implementation of iterative models to assess performance and benefits.
- FY25 funding gap due to delayed budget and/or inadequate funding for study.
- HQ interpretation limiting authority of 201(a)(22) of WRDA 2020 –
  - Only measures that address hazards traditionally within Corps mission areas are allowed to be cost shared for design/construction (not Tidal or SLR)

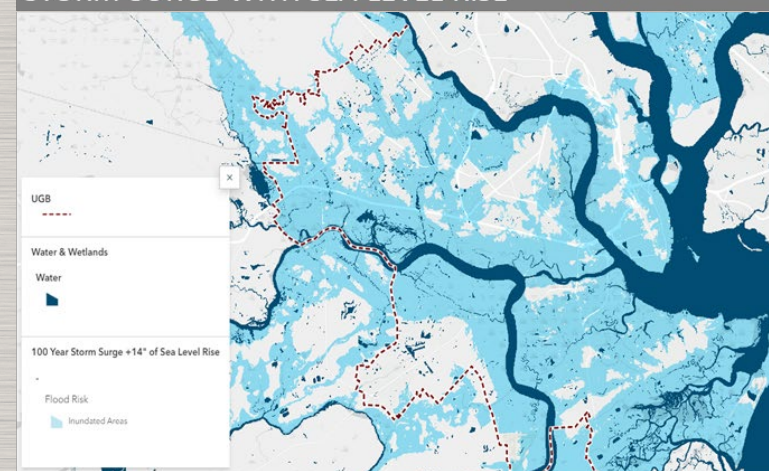

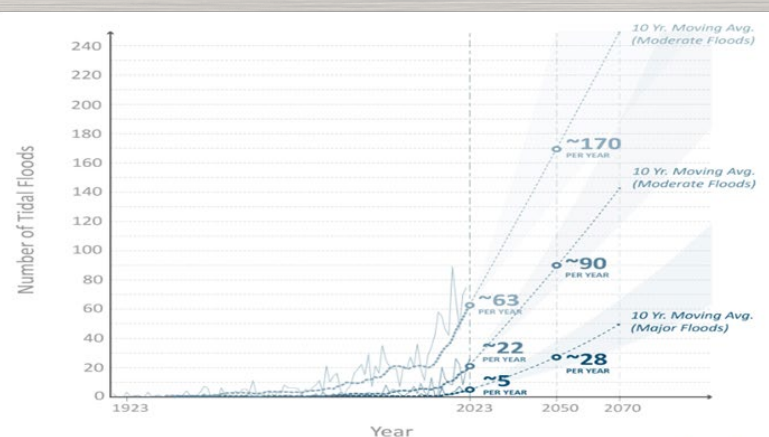

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# ENVIRONMENTAL INFRASTRUCTURE

## Lakes Marion & Moultrie

The primary goal of the project is to provide potable water to central South Carolina, using Lake Marion as a source

- Current Status
  - Construction ongoing for Winding Woods Reach (8mi) and Tank, and the Providence Reach (1.5mi)
  - Orangeburg-Berkeley Phase 1 (8mi) underway
  - Orangeburg-Berkeley Phase 2 (8 mi) underway
  - Calhoun (22mi) Reaches are in the design phase
    - Cameron Reach award in FY25
    - St. Matthews Reach award in FY26
  - Plant Upgrade (8 to 12MGD) is in design phase
    - Current Authorization: \$165,000,000; WRDA 22 (P.L. 117-263) Dec 23, 2022
    - Total Federal Allocations to Date: \$138,898,830



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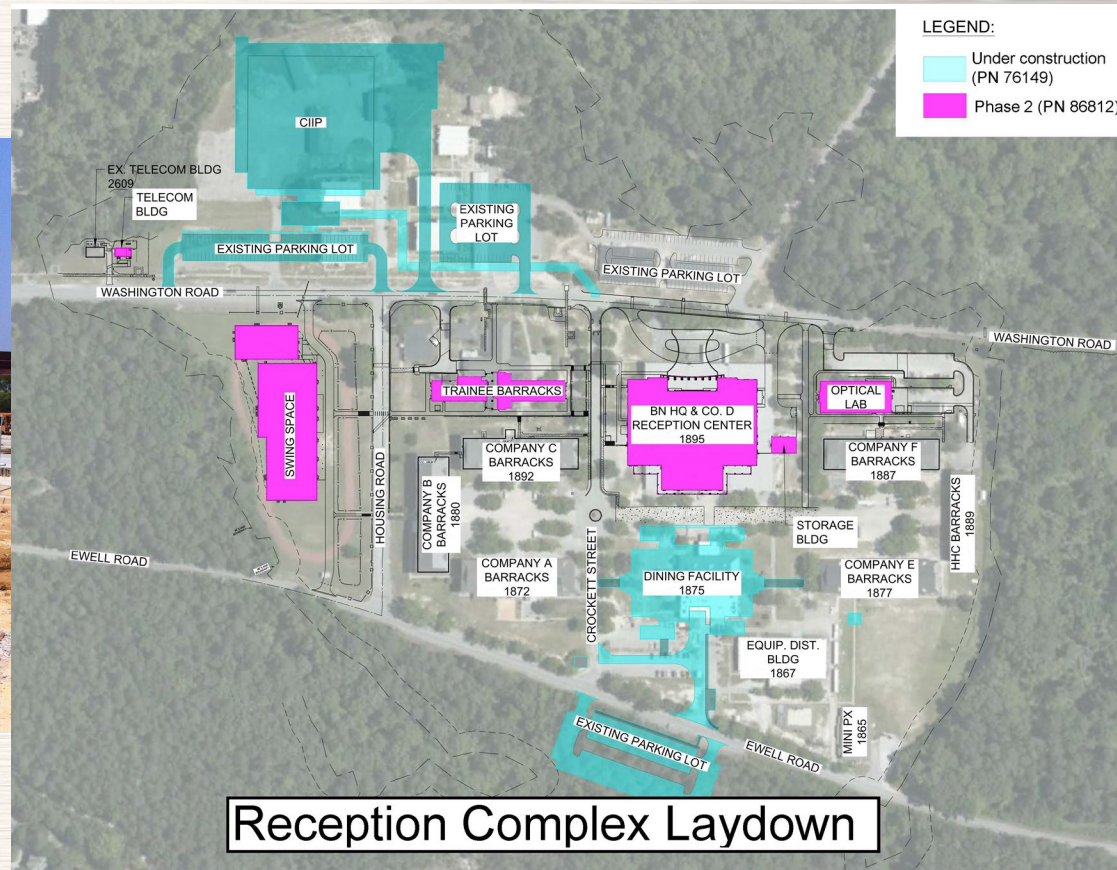

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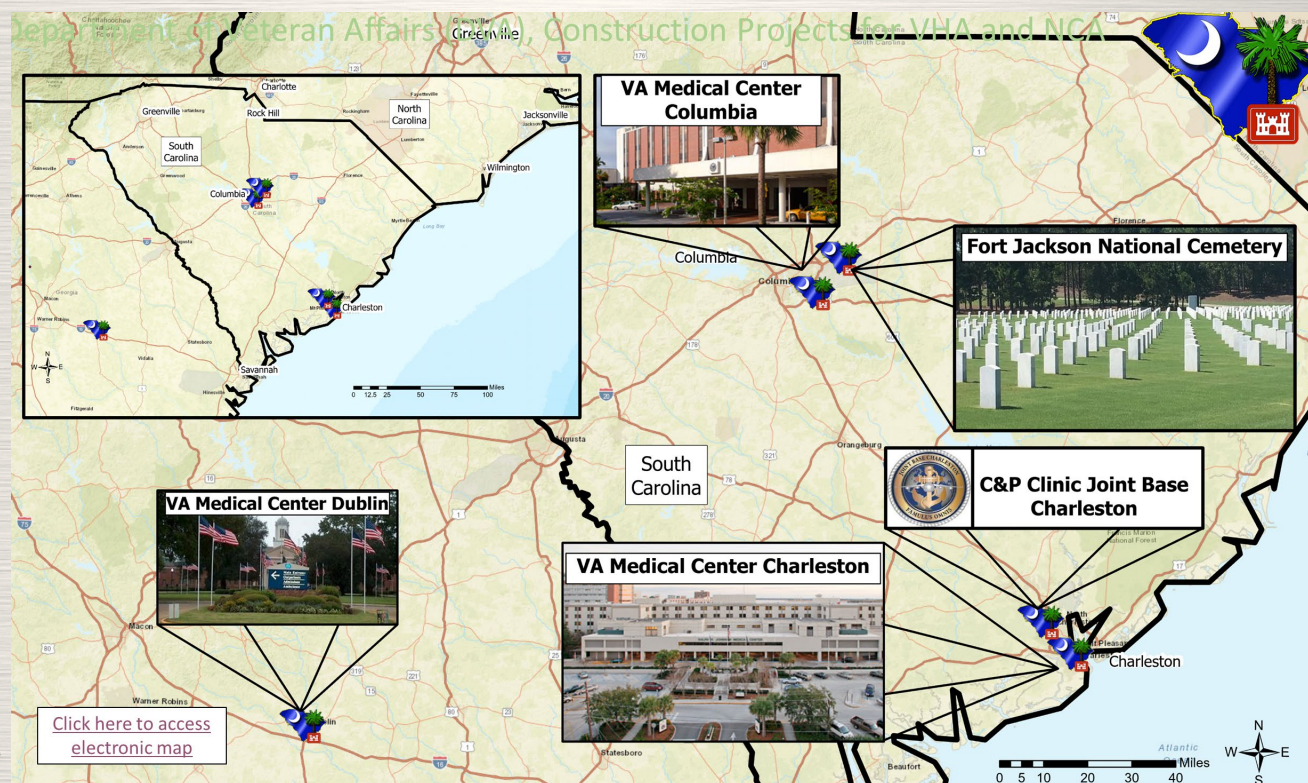


# VETERANS ADMINISTRATION PROJECTS

- Charleston District executes “minor” projects (<\$30M) across the SAD AOR (Southeast US).
- This program covers 7 states and Puerto Rico; 23 major hospitals (VAMC); 140+ outpatient clinics (CBOCs); over 2.5M enrolled veterans.
- Over \$148M awarded since FY07.

- Potential for more work ...

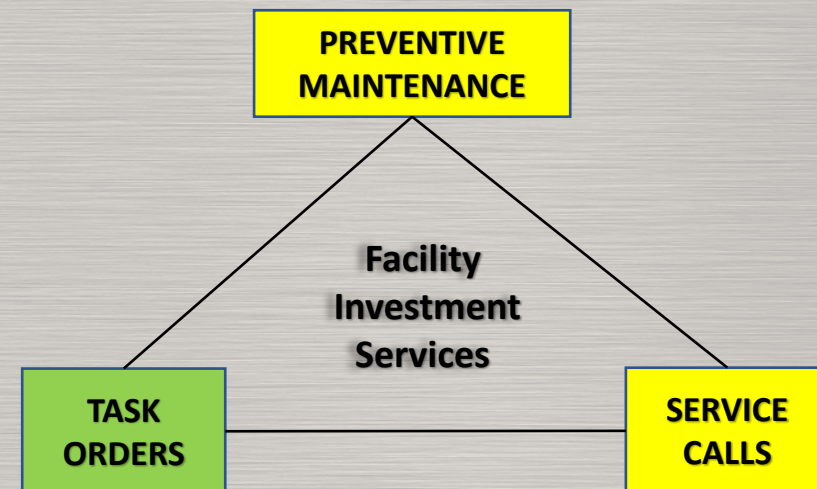


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# FACILITY INVESTMENT SERVICES (FIS) OVERVIEW

- FIS contracts are:
  - Maintenance based – HVAC, chillers, valves, etc
  - Proactive, not reactive
  - Competitive, not sole-source
  - Rapid execution – services calls & Task Orders can be expedited
  - Enable focused oversight and historical trends
  - Enable long-term acquisition planning and shelf-ready projects
- Three components to a typical contract:
  - Preventive maintenance (aka “oil change”)
    - Routine, pre-defined based on equipment
    - Regularly scheduled by contractor
    - Firm fixed price
  - Service call (aka “alternator replacement”)
    - On-demand, pre-paid, up to \$2,500
  - IDIQ Task order (aka “engine replacement”)
    - \$2,500 or above
    - Negotiated per task order
    - Not pre-paid, funds required as needed per task order

## Best Practices for Those Who Want to Work With Us

- ❖ **Read and respond to our sources sought** notices in accordance with the announcement. Contracting can make the best procurement decisions when provided with requested information.
- ❖ **Ensure realistic lead times for ordering parts** to avoid delays in installation and meeting scheduled deadlines. Failure to plan accordingly can impact project timelines and overall performance that can be reflected on CPARS.
- ❖ **Reach out to our Small Business Professional for a Capabilities Briefing** - but do your research! Review our current projections/upcoming projects and see what may interest you and be prepared to speak about it.
- ❖ If you feel as if you are a good fit to do the work that we have out on solicitation but realize your proposal would be unsuccessful because you can't meet the criteria for things like past performance or past experience, **reach out to the Contracting Officer or submit a RFI** through the means identified in the solicitation. Sometimes we are more restrictive than we realize, we don't know that until you tell us!

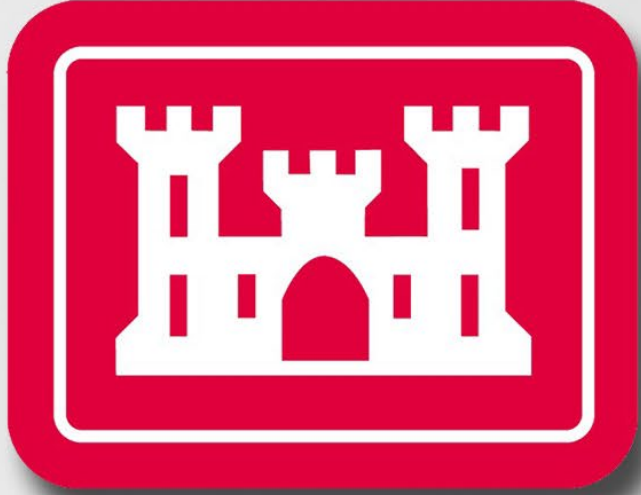
